You may be affected by road closure disturbances on 5 September.

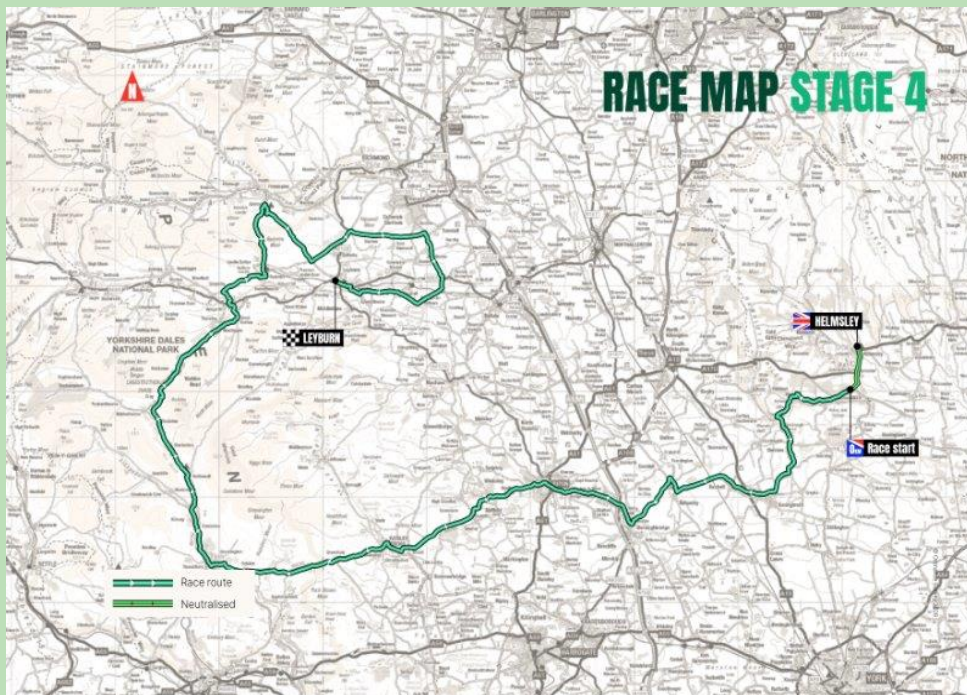
Here's everything you need to know.

Dear Resident,

The Lloyds Tour of Britain, the UK's largest professional cycling race, will be passing through your area this summer, and will involve temporary road closures that may affect your local travel and access.

We recognise that these temporary closures may disrupt your daily routine and local journeys, and we appreciate your patience and understanding while these measures are in place. This letter provides clear information on the dates, times and locations of road closures, as well as guidance on how you can continue to access your area and plan your journeys. We hope this helps minimise any inconvenience and enables you to enjoy this significant sporting event - we'd love to see you there, cheering on the teams from the roadside.

Will I still be able to access my home or business on race day?

We understand that access is important. Temporary road closures will be in place, but these are known as rolling road closures, meaning they are only restricted for 15 – 30 minutes. You can access full details of timings, road access and suggested travel on our website using the QR code below, this will help you to plan your journeys in advance.

IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION



TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

Roads on and near the race route, including the neutralised section, will close briefly as riders pass. Yellow advance warning signs will be in place, and police escort vehicles will signal when the race is approaching.



PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Parking will not be allowed on the race route on the day. Some areas will be restricted in the days leading up to the race, marked with yellow cones. Parking in start and finish towns will be restricted from the night before.



POLICE PRESENCE

The race is supported by trained police officers and escort motorcyclists. Please follow their instructions to help keep everyone safe.



ADVANCE WARNING

An information vehicle will travel the route around 15 minutes ahead of the race, sharing live updates so you know when the riders are coming.



STAYING SAFE

Riders pass at speed. Please stand well back from the road, keep pets on a lead, and keep flags, phones and cameras out of the roadway. Always face the oncoming race.
